

The obsolete parts are still effective and do not require changing out.

#### 455 Balanced regulator P/N 505-455

- The Balance Spacer, P/N 550-549 will no longer be dark grey in color.
- The NEW COLOR will be BROWN. NO PART NUMBER CHANGE.

### **Balanced SCUBA regulator P/N 200-120**

The Balance Piston, P/N 250-029 is obsolete and will no longer be used in the Main Tube Assembly P/N 205-030.

Change to the Main Tube Assembly: The obsolete P/N 250-029 is replaced by the two parts below.

- The **Balance Spacer** P/N 550-549 is **brown** in **color**.
- Washer P/N 250-065 must be used when using the new color, brown Balance Spacer in the Balanced SCUBA regulator.
  (Washer NOT to be used with the original dark grey P/N 250-029)

Reminder: Change-out to the current parts is not necessary. There is no upgrade to perform.
